



DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY BY THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF TOPSAIL BEACH

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Topsail Beach has duly adopted ordinances pursuant to the provisions of N.C. G.S. 166A Article 1A to determine and proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to impose certain prohibitions and restrictions appropriate to meet the emergency; and

WHEREAS, In response to the global spread of the virus and the disease it causes, the World Health Organization has declared COVID-19 a Public Health Emergency; the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has warned of the high public health threat posed by COVID-19 globally; and the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS) confirmed cases of COVID-19 in North Carolina as of March 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Governor Cooper issued Executive Order No. 116 titled “Declaration of a State of Emergency to Coordinate Response and Protective Actions to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19, and subsequent executive orders pursuant to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, based upon guidance from CDC and NCDHHS, arrangements must be made to take appropriate action to ensure that COVID-19 remains controlled and that residents and visitors of Topsail Beach will remain safe and secure.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Steven G. Smith, Mayor of the Town of Topsail Beach does hereby proclaim:

I

A State of Emergency exists in the Town of Topsail Beach due to the expected impacts of COVID-19.

II

The emergency area covered by this state of emergency shall be for the territorial limits of the Town of Topsail Beach


III
