

Help Keep Topsail Beach Clean

Do NOT dump or throw anything into the ditches, inlets, or storm drains. Even grass clippings and branches can accumulate and plug channels, increasing flood hazards.



According to Section 14-74 of the Town of Topsail Beach's Code of Ordinances,

It shall be unlawful to dump, deposit, or otherwise cause any trash, landscape debris, or other material to be placed in the Town's drainage system or in any stream, channel, ditch, pond, basin, or inlet, that regularly or periodically carries or stores water.

Bulk items (tree limbs, shrubbery, cuttings, leaves, etc.) are picked up by the Town of Topsail Beach on the 1st and 3rd Friday of every month. Bulk collections should be placed in neat piles and located along the road. NO waste building materials or lot clearings will be collected by the Town.
